The Julian Triangle Club is pleased to offer academic scholarships to any graduating senior who plans to attend a two to four year college. The Julian Triangle Club also offers scholarships to a graduating senior planning to attend a Vocational or Trade School.

Any graduating senior of Julian High School, Ray Redding High School, Julian Charter School, or home school who resides in the Julian High School District boundaries planning to continue his or her education may apply for these scholarships.

The scholarships are awarded based upon citizenship, scholarship, community, and school activities. Final selection will be made by the Julian Triangle Club Scholarship Committee. The announcement of the high school recipients will be made at the Julian High School Awards Ceremony in June. For recipients outside of Julian High School, ie: Charter and home school, notification will be sent by mail.

Application forms that are not filled out completely and properly will not be considered for a Julian Triangle Club Scholarship. Do not leave any blanks; if an item is not applicable to you, please write N/A so we know you saw it. Applications that are not received by April 14th will not be considered for a Julian Triangle Club Scholarship.
